

AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDING



Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (CSFRF/CLFRF)

The U.S. Treasury directly distributed funds within Wyoming to:

- The State for distribution to Non-Entitlement Units (NEUs) (\$47.8 million),
- Counties (\$112.4 million),
- Metropolitan Cities (\$21.3 million), and
- Tribal Governments

Funding objectives include:

- Support Public Health Response
- Replace Public Sector Revenue Loss
- Water and Sewer Infrastructure
- Address Negative Economic Impact Funds
- Broadband Infrastructure

Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Requirements:

- Current Capital Improvement Plan (CIP)
- Current Fiscal Sustainability Plan (FSP)

Reauthorization of the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) may require a CIP and FSP in order to apply for Drinking Water State Revolving Funds (DWSRF).

- CIPs and FSPs are the first step to securing project funding for clean water and drinking water projects

Acceptable use of CSFRF for NEUs is the development and/or update of CIP and FSP for application to CWSRF and DWSRF through the State Land and Investment Board (SLIB)

- Funds made available to NEUs should fully fund the development of a CIP and FSP
- Can easily meet obligation and expending deadlines
- Ensures access to Infrastructure Bill funding through SLIB & other funding

\$3 Billion in Additional funding through U.S. Economic Development Administration

- Economic Adjustment Assistance
- Travel, Tourism, Outdoor Rec
- Indigenous Communities
- Statewide Planning
- Good Jobs Challenge
